I am directed to refer to this Department's letter No.FD (SR.I) 6-1/2000 dated 18-05-2002 on the subject noted above and to say that in pursuance of Government of Pakistan, Finance Division's Office Memorandum No.F.3(2)R-4/2011 dated 24-12-2012, the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is pleased to revise the Management Position (MP) salary package, perquisites and facilities w.e.f 01-01-2014 as follows:-

Note:-

- The pay of an incumbent will be fixed at the corresponding stage in the revised MP Scale at which he was drawing pay before revision.
- ii) The revised MP package will be automatically admissible to the existing incumbents working in MP Scales. However, the extension, if required, of the existing contract of MP Scale holders, will be considered only if their performance is found satisfactory after evaluation by the Performance Evaluation Committee and approval of the competent authority as per rules.
- iii) Transport facility with POL limits at par with equivalent Basic Pay Scales or its monetized value as per policy of the Provincial Government would also be admissible to the officers so approved.
- iv) The above scales may be allowed for suitable positions only with prior approval / concurrence of the Finance Department.
