(c) Service Tribunal Act (LXX of 1975)

S. 4 Constitution of Pakistan (1973), Art.212---Appeal to Service Tribunal or Supreme Court---  
Effect---If the Service Tribunal or Supreme Court decides a point of law relating to the terms of  
service of a civil servants which covers not only the case of civil servants who litigated, but also  
of other civil servants, who may have not taken any legal proceedings, in such a case, the dictates  
and rule of good governance demand that the benefit of such judgment by service  
Tribunal/Supreme Court be extended to other civil servants, who may not be parties to the  
litigation instead of compelling them to approach the Service Tribunal or any other forum. [p.
